#### LESS IS ALWAYS MORE



Chances are you already have all the necessary embellishments you need and all you have to do is take away the rest.



#### TIPS & TRICKS FOR THE SMALLER AREAS

Small areas can look very cluttered if there are too many items sharing the space. Even when the items are beautiful. If you are in doubt, try gently reminding yourself that the hero of the photoshoot is the house. Not the items in it.

### SOME GOOD ADVICE



#### CLEAN AND DECLUTTER:

THOROUGHLY CLEAN YOUR PROPERTY, ENSURING THAT ALL SURFACES, FLOORS, WINDOWS, AND MIRRORS ARE SPOTLESS. REMOVE ANY CLUTTER, PERSONAL ITEMS, OR EXCESSIVE DECORATIONS TO CREATE A CLEAN AND VISUALLY APPEALING SPACE.



#### DEPERSONALIZE THE SPACE:

REMOVE PERSONAL PHOTOGRAPHS, UNIQUE ARTWORK, OR ITEMS THAT MAY DISTRACT POTENTIAL BUYERS. THIS ALLOWS THEM TO ENVISION THEMSELVES IN THE SPACE MORE EASILY.



#### ORGANIZE AND STAGE EACH ROOM:

ARRANGE FURNITURE AND DECOR TO SHOWCASE THE FUNCTIONALITY AND FLOW OF EACH ROOM. CREATE FOCAL POINTS AND HIGHLIGHT THE PROPERTY'S BEST FEATURES.




#### MAXIMIZE NATURAL LIGHT:

OPEN CURTAINS OR BLINDS TO LET IN NATURAL LIGHT, WHICH CAN MAKE ROOMS APPEAR LARGER, BRIGHTER, AND MORE INVITING. ENSURE THAT ALL LIGHT BULBS ARE IN WORKING ORDER, AND CONSIDER USING WARMER LIGHT BULBS TO CREATE A COZY AMBIANCE.



#### CONSIDER CURB APPEAL:

THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR PROPERTY SETS THE FIRST IMPRESSION. TRIM THE LANDSCAPING, MOW THE LAWN, REMOVE ANY DEBRIS, AND CONSIDER ADDING POTTED PLANTS OR FLOWERS TO ENHANCE THE VISUAL APPEAL.



#### TIDY UP OUTDOOR AREAS:

CLEAN DECKS, PATIOS, AND OUTDOOR FURNITURE.
REMOVE ANY UNNECESSARY ITEMS, AND STAGE OUTDOOR
SPACES TO SHOWCASE THEIR POTENTIAL FOR RELAXATION
OR ENTERTAINMENT.

### SOME GOOD ADVICE



#### ENHANCE DETAILS AND FEATURES:

PAY ATTENTION TO SMALL DETAILS THAT CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE, SUCH AS REPLACING WORN-OUT OR OUTDATED HARDWARE, ADDING FRESH FLOWERS OR PLANTS, AND ENSURING THAT FIXTURES, FAUCETS, AND APPLIANCES ARE CLEAN AND IN GOOD CONDITION.




#### HIDE OR REMOVE PERSONAL ITEMS:

STORE AWAY PERSONAL ITEMS SUCH AS TOILETRIES, TOWELS, AND CLEANING SUPPLIES. CLEAR BATHROOM AND KITCHEN COUNTERS OF UNNECESSARY ITEMS TO CREATE A CLEAN AND SPACIOUS FEEL.




#### CHECK FOR MAINTENANCE ISSUES:

FIX ANY VISIBLE MAINTENANCE ISSUES, SUCH AS LEAKY FAUCETS, LOOSE DOORKNOBS, OR PEELING PAINT. ADDRESSING THESE ISSUES PRIOR TO THE PHOTO SESSION ENSURES A POLISHED AND WELL-MAINTAINED APPEARANCE.



#### DIFFERENT ANGLES & PERSPECTIVES:

REVIEW YOUR ROOMS FROM VARIOUS ANGLES AND PERSPECTIVES. YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER WILL DO EXACTLY THAT TO SHOWCASE THE PROPERTY'S UNIQUE FEATURES, CAPTURING BOTH WIDE SHOTS AND CLOSE-UPS OF INTERESTING DETAILS IN IMPERATIVE.



#### ENSURE CLEAN WINDOWS

CLEAN WINDOWS AND REFLECTIVE SURFACES PLAY A CRUCIAL ROLE IN THE OVERALL APPEARANCE OF YOUR PROPERTY'S INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR. BY ENSURING THAT WINDOWS AND REFLECTIVE SURFACES ARE CLEAN AND STREAK-FREE, YOU ENHANCE THE VISUAL APPEAL OF YOUR PROPERTY'S INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR, MAKING IT MORE ENTICING FOR PROSPECTIVE BUYERS OR RENTERS.



#### ENHANCED VISIBILITY:

MAKE SURE THAT ALL THE LIGHTBULBS ARE WORKING AND INSTALLED. SETTING UP THE RIGHT KIND OF AMBIENCE CAN BE INSTRUMENTAL IN CREATING THE RIGHT IMAGE.


